I can explain how to be a kind friend.

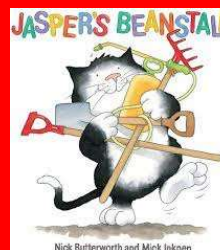
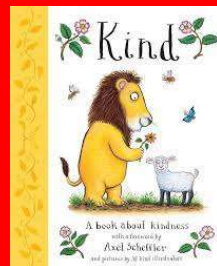
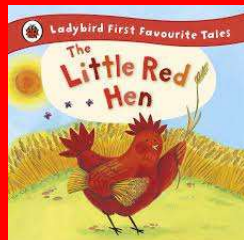
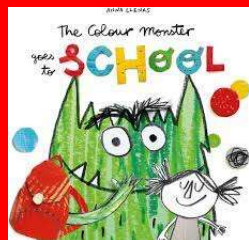
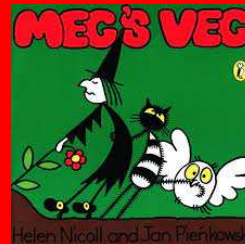
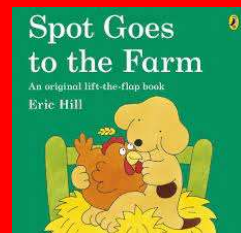
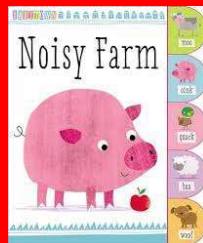
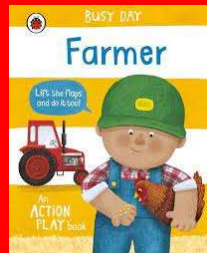


## Essential Vocabulary
