I know that a map helps me find where to go.

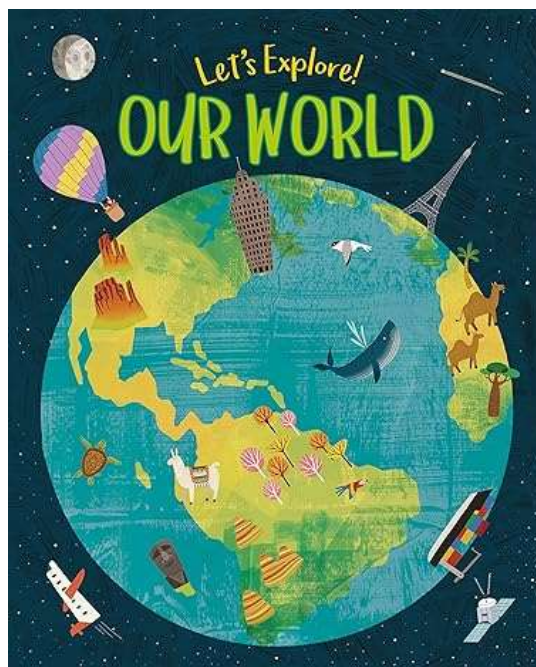
I know how old I am.

I can explain how I am feeling.

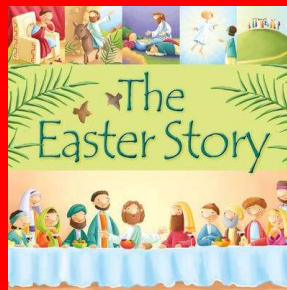
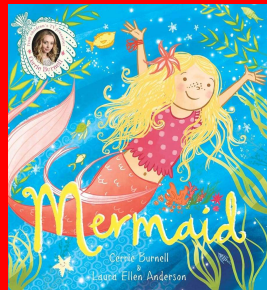
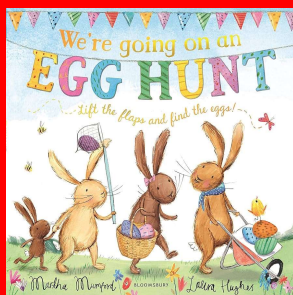
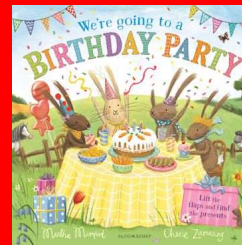
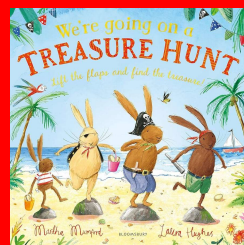
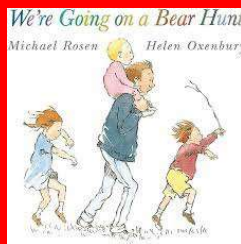
