Firm Foundations in Phonics 1- 'Wrap them in Rhyme'

- Aspect 1 – Environmental Sounds (General Sound Discrimination)
- Aspect 2 - Instrumental Sounds (General Sound Discrimination)
- Aspect 3 – Body Percussion (General Sound Discrimination)
- Aspect 4 – Rhythm and Rhyme (Phonological Awareness)
 - Aspect 5 – Alliteration (Phonological Awareness)
 - Aspect 6 – Voice Sounds (Phonological Awareness)
- Aspect 7 – Oral Segmenting and Blending (Phonological Awareness)

Firm Foundations in Phonics 1 gives children playful daily repeated experience, exposure and enjoyment of General Sound Discrimination and Phonological Awareness.

In order for a child to be ready for the Basics 2, they would need to demonstrate that they were able to tune in to, listen to and remember and talk about sounds. They would need to be skilled in Rhythm and Rhyme, Alliteration and Oral Blending and Segmenting before they start to look at the shapes of the letters on flashcards and begin their systematic, synthetic phonics journey.
